
~Updates for this year's show~

Wine Country Classic Boats, Inc. 2011 REGATTA/RACE RELEASE FORM (POWER BOAT) REGATTA RULES

The Board of Directors of the Wine Country Classic Boats, Inc., Chapter of the Antique and Classic Boat Society, Inc. have established the following criteria, for all boats and drivers participating in the Regatta:

- Single engine unless originally equipped with more than one.
- Engine must be similar in design and horsepower to original engine for Antique or Classic boat categories.
- Mono-hull bottom design, single planing hulls, displacement hulls, and step hulls allowed.

NO THREE-POINT HYDROPLANES WILL BE ALLOWED.

- Driver must attend designated safety and instructional meeting prior to Regatta.
- Safety Committee must inspect all boats participating in the Regatta for proper USCG equipment including flotation devices, fire extinguishers, signaling devices and anchors.
- Regatta Committee will inspect boats for any irregularities per WCCB, Inc., rules.
- ALL occupants must wear USCG approved life jackets at all times during the Regatta.
- The boat must be pre-registered by July 11, 2011.
- All boats participating in the Regatta on Sunday and **not registered for the Show** on Saturday will be expected to pay a fee of \$20 for each such participation.
- All owners of boats participating in the Regatta will be required to submit a completed registration form and a signed/dated waiver of liability (Release Form) for each boat participating.
- The Regatta Committee must agree upon any exceptions to the above. The Committee's decisions are final.

I certify that I have the following approved equipment on board: FIRE EXTINGUISHER (S); PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICES; ANCHOR; HORN/WHISTLE. I have read the regatta rules above and agree to be bound by them. I believe the above statement and information to be true.
